the time required to complete a full cycle that a point completes after last passing through the reference or zero position for example the reference position for the hands of a clock is at the numeral 12 and the minute hand has a period of one hour web phase fāz any of the forms recurring in cycles in which the moon or a planet appears in the sky one of a set of possible homogenous discrete states of a physical system states of matter such as solid and liquid are examples of phases as are different crystal lattice structures in metals such as iron web a phase is one of the forms in which
