falkland islands islas malvinas the world factbook Jul 23 2022 jan 10 2023 background although first sighted by an english navigator in 1592 the first landing english did not occur until almost a century later in 1690 and the first settlement french was not established until 1764 the colony was turned over to spain two years later and the islands have since been the subject of a territorial dispute first between britain and spain then

**falkland islands wikipedia** Dec 28 2022 the falklands consists of continental crust fragments resulting from the break up of gondwana and the opening of the south atlantic that began 130 million years ago the islands are located in the south atlantic ocean on the patagonian shelf about 300 mi 480 km east of patagonia in southern argentina

**falkland islands history britannica** Aug 24 2022 argentina based its claim to the falklands on papal bulls of 1493 modified by the treaty of tordesillas 1494 by which spain and portugal had divided the new world between themselves on succession from spain on the islands proximity to south america and on the need to end a colonial situation britain based its claim on its open continuous effective possession
