leopards are powerful big cats closely related to lions tigers and jaguars they live in sub saharan africa northeast africa central asia india and china however many of their populations the leopard s coat does not belong on humans these big cats have long been hunted for their soft fur used to make coats and ceremonial robes as well as for their claws whiskers and tails which are popular as fetishes leopards can be a nuisance to locals when brought into close contact with human settlements they may prey on livestock the african leopard exhibits great variation in coat color depending on location and habitat coat colour varies from pale yellow to deep gold or tawny and sometimes black and is patterned with black rosettes while the head lower limbs and belly are spotted with solid black male leopards are larger averaging 58 kg 128 lb with 90 kg 200 lb being the maximum weight attained by jul 15 2021 leopards are larger than a house cat but leopards are the smallest members of the large cat category they grow to only 3 to 6 2 feet 92 to 190 centimeters long their tail adds another 25 to 39 leopards are very solitary and spend most of their time alone they each have their own territory and leave scratches on trees urine scent marks and poop to warn other leopards to stay away males and females will cross territories but only to mate 5 these big cats have a varied diet and enjoy different kinds of grub the leopard panthera pardus is a member of the felidae family with a wide range in some parts of africa and tropical asia from siberia south and west asia to across most of sub saharan leopard panthera pardus also called panther large cat closely related to the lion tiger and jaguar the name leopard was originally given to the cat now called cheetah the so called hunting leopard which was once thought to be a cross between the lion and the pard the term pard was eventually replaced by the name leopard temperate broadleaf and mixed forests people usually think of leopards in the savannas of africa but in the russian far east a rare subspecies has adapted to life in the temperate forests that make up the northern most part of the species range similar to other leopards the amur leopard can run at speeds of up to 37 miles per hour leopards are graceful and powerful big cats closely related to lions tigers and jaguars they live in sub saharan africa northeast africa central asia india and china however many of their the leopard panthera pardus is one of the five extant species in the genus panthera a member of the cat family felidae it occurs in a wide range in sub saharan africa in some parts of western and central asia southern russia and on the
